Each year the Missouri Association for College Admission Counseling (MOACAC) is pleased to offer two \$1000 Braxton Rethwisch scholarship to a student who exhibits a commitment to learning and has demonstrated leadership skills and community service involvement. **Each applicant's high school counselor must be a member of MOACAC.**

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must be a graduating senior from a MOACAC member high school who will be enrolled as a full-time college freshman at a MOACAC member post-secondary institution.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Receive recommendation from the nominating high school counselor. (Note: Students must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 to be considered for this scholarship. Counselor verification will be required.) The counselor recommendation form can be accessed [here](#).

SELECTION CRITERIA

- All completed **applications must be submitted by Wednesday, March 1st** and must be endorsed by a school counselor.
- Applications will be reviewed by MOACAC's Inclusion, Access, and Success Committee.
- Selection criteria includes: senior at MOACAC member high school, personal essay, co-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, and counselor recommendation.
- Applicants will be notified of scholarship decisions by Wednesday, March 22nd.
- Recipients will be officially recognized at the 2017 MOACAC Conference. The winners' names will be posted after April 14th on the MOACAC website.
